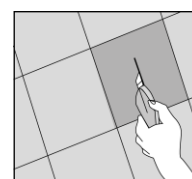


REPAIRING GLUE DOWN FLOORS

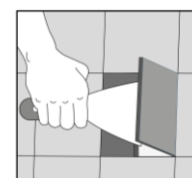
Replacing a damaged plank

The following tools and materials are required in order to remove a plank from an installed area: Knife, chisel, trowel, scraper, levelling compound and adhesive.

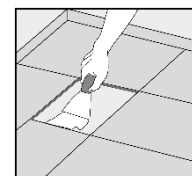
To remove the damaged tile you must cut out the center with a knife.



Lift the tile up, from the center to the edges using a scraper. This method will avoid damaging the adjacent tiles.



Try to remove the tile without damaging the subfloor. If this is not possible, the subfloor should be filled with a suitable levelling compound. Be caution with this, to ensure that the subfloor is completely flat and smooth.



Use a recommended contact adhesive to glue the new tile into place. Follow the installation instructions on its label.

Press the tile down and place some weight on top while the adhesive dries. Avoid traffic immediately after to ensure perfect adhesion. Remove any surplus adhesive.
